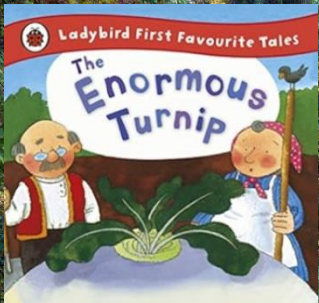
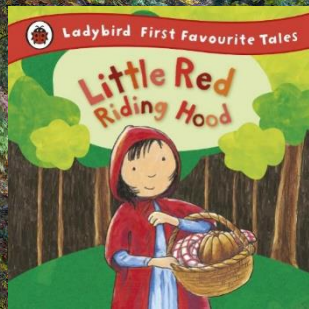


Year 1 Term 5

The Enchanted Woodland



English

Listening to and discussing a range of fairy tales and traditional tales before planning and writing our own.

Writing our own instructions.

DT

Designing, making, and decorating our own puppets using felt and staples to join the fabric.

Geography

We will use aerial photos to discuss and learn about features of our local area and our place in the world. We will learn how to create our own maps of the school with a key.

Maths

Multiplication and Division: the children will build on their previous knowledge of counting in multiples of 2, 5 and 10. Fractions: using shapes and objects to find half.

PSHE

Our topic is 'Relationships'. We will learn about how relationships help us to feel safe and good about ourselves and the role we play within relationships.

PE

Striking and Fielding & Team Building. The children will develop the skills required in games such as rounders and cricket and learn how to work together and achieve a set goal as a team.

The Enchanted Woodland

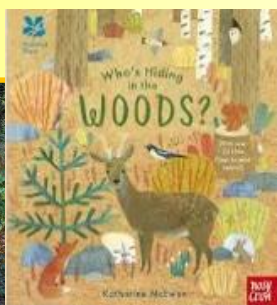
This term we will be using our imaginations to create our own fairy tales. We will be learning about common plants and trees in science and taking our learning outside with forest school!
