Religious Education

Computing

Branching databases

The children will create physical and on-screen branching databases, using them to make decisions.

Design Technology Pneumatic Toys

We will be designing a toy that uses a pneumatic system to create movements, creating it and evaluating the design. We will be learning that different types of drawings are used in design to explain ideas clearly.

English

Writing a nonchronological report about an imaginary rainforest animal, using the features to give real impact to their writing. The children will also write their own narrative and poems.

Under the Canopy

We will continue to find out about the rainforest, learning about deforestation, the flora and fauna which live in it and the impact the rainforests

Maths

To use fractions and compare them to their equivalent. We will look at fractions in real life contexts. We then move onto mass and capacity, understanding how to apply this to solve problems.

Science **Plants**

The children will learn about the parts of flowering plants and their functions. They will observe what happens to plants when they are put in different environments. We also learn about seed dispersal.

Art **Rainforests**

The children will learn about adding texture to observational drawings, and using Henri Rousseau as inspiration.
