

Year 3 Term 4

English

Writing a non-chronological report about an imaginary rainforest animal, using the features to give real impact to their writing. The children will also write their own narrative and poems.

The children will be thinking about who has the authority to decide what happens if we do wrong, how others' beliefs may impact on how they live their lives.
