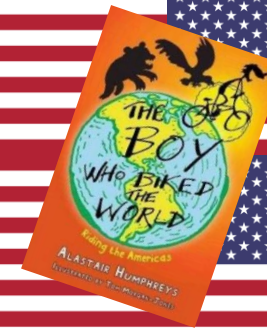


Year group: 4 Term 2

English
