UPDATE SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN

A couple of weeks ago, we circulated a poster alerting you to the potential risk to children from private fostering. Private fostering is when a child under 16 (or 18 if they have a disability) is cared for by someone who is not a close relative for 28 days or more. Common examples of private fostering include a teenager living with a friend's family because of issues at home or children living with a friend's family because their parents' study or work involves unsociable hours, which make it difficult to use ordinary day care or after school care.
