YEAR 3 INDIAN CULTURAL EXPERIENCES

I am delighted to inform you that we have organised for the Year 3 class to take part in two Indian cultural experiences that will support the class' learning.

The first Indian experience will take place within school on **Thursday 18 January**. Sunita Patel will spend a day with the class, teaching Indian culture, food, music and dance. The children will also dress in traditional costumes and create Indian art patterns. The day will be funded by the school.

The second Indian experience will take place on **Monday 5 February**. The class will visit Maharani's Restaurant in Deeping St James. The children will learn about Indian food culture seeing how the food is prepared and will then be served a selection of dishes.

The children will leave school at 10.15 am and be transported to and from the restaurant by *Coaches of Langtoft*, paid for by F.O.L.S. The children will return to school at approximately 1.00 pm.

If you are concerned that your child does not enjoy Indian cuisine and will therefore not eat enough food at the restaurant, we suggest that a packed lunch is brought to school, which can be eaten, if required, when we return to school following the visit. Please do not order a hot school meal for this day. Please also inform the school office staff if your child has any dietary allergies before the visit.

Off-site visits of this nature are extremely beneficial in supporting the children's learning and we therefore intend to take the whole Year 3 class. However, if you should have any queries regarding this visit, please do not hesitate to contact me.
