

Stone Age to the Iron Age

Year 3 Term 1



History

We will be researching changes from the Stone Age to the Iron Age and use secondary sources of evidence to find out what life was like during the time period.

Maths

We have started the year with Place Value and Number, understanding the value of each digit in any number up to 1000. After this we will move onto addition and subtraction using a range of methods, including column method and looking for links between the numbers.

Computing

Computer Systems and Networks

We will be learning how computers are connected and how computers help us to do things more efficiently. We will learn the names of different parts of a computer network and learn what job they do.

PSHE

Being Me in My World

We start the year by finding out who our community is and how we are part of it. We learn what it takes to have a harmonious community, including in our class community and school.



English

We are going to be immersing ourselves into the Stone Age in English, and finding out about a boy who goes on a time-travelling adventure back in time.... We will write a retelling of the story, focussing on the setting description. We will also look at instructions, learning what make an effective set of instructions and the key features.

Art and Design

The learning will start using a story as a stimulus, finding out the story behind the 'Lion Man', using this to inspire us to create our own 3D sculptures using clay.
